Description of Works

Installation of a temporary prefabricated café about the size of a 6m shipping container to sell coffee and food next to Lake Burley Griffin. Located on Wendouree Drive near Lake Burley Griffin and Blundell's Cottage, see Drawing DA001.

Site Location Summary

The site chosen for the café was proposed by the National Capital Authority, located in the Central Basin near to Lake Burley Griffin and Blundell's Cottage.

Wendouree Parks Drive is closed in this section and is for pedestrian and service vehicle use only. The café will be located between two trees at the end of the existing parking area, which is discrete and blends into the landscape.

The design of the café was proposed to have suitable aesthetic quality for the area and fits with the Heritage Status of Blundell's Cottage. See Heritage Impact Statement attached.

Work Schedule

Fabrication of the café will take 8 weeks once works approval granted.

Once approval has been granted entities will be notified to arrange connection to required services on site.

Timeframe

The timeframe for installation will take 1 day for locating the café on site.

Connection to services will require plugging into power and connecting the tap for water.

Materials and Colours

The materials proposed for café include: Cladding – James Hardie Axon Smooth Grey Pebble Doors – Clear glazing External Metalwork – Sierra Pacific Black Roof - Colorbond Monument. Windows – Smoky grey glazing.
